PLEASE NOTE: As agreed by the county, the following will apply. Archers meeting the criteria below must shoot the Long National.

**Lady recurve archer with a handicap of 50 = 436 National**  
**Gent recurve archer with a handicap of 44 = 500 National**  
**Lady compound with a handicap of 42 = 518 National**  
**Gent compound archer with a handicap of 37 = 555 National**

- Juniors wishing to shoot in the senior rounds will pay the senior fee to do so, and will be competing against the seniors
- Juniors wishing to shoot a higher round than their own (within the junior rounds) will still pay the junior fee, but will compete against the age group they are shooting in for medals.
- If an archer wishes to shoot in an age group that is lower than their own, they can do but they will not be eligible for any medals.
- Medals will be awarded over all categories depending on how many archers are shooting within that category, as follows:  
  
Gold = awarded if there are 1-3 people shooting  
Silver = awarded if there are 4-6 people shooting  
Bronze = awarded if there are 7 or more people shooting

\*Please ensure Junior distances are specified correctly when filling out the entry form, as there may not be room to move people around on the day\*
