Bowbrook Archers Bank Holiday Shoot, 29/30 August 2020

This is a formal but friendly competition, open primarily to members and associates of Bowbrook Archers, with any extra places available to lockdown affiliates and archers from around the county.

Seniors will shoot on Saturday 29 August, Juniors on Sunday 30 August.

This event is in the form of a WA (World Archery) 720 round and involves shooting a total of 72 arrows, in ends of 6, at a target which is a set distance away. The official distances for a WA round is 50m or 70m, depending on bow type.

However, we appreciate that many of our club members do not feel ready to shoot these distances, so at this event the competitors may choose what distance they wish to shoot. For seniors it will be a choice of 30, 40, 50, 60 or 70m, for juniors it will be 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 or 70m. So, on the entry form you will need to select your preferred distance. Be ambitious – do not necessarily stay well within your comfort zone. All targets will be 122cm diameter, apart from compounds who have the opportunity to shoot at 80cm faces.

Current regulations mean that we can only have up to 30 people involved in the event at any one time so we will have a morning and afternoon session on both days. Please indicate on the entry form which session you would prefer. On Sunday Juniors will be shooting. As many of the juniors will be accompanied by adults, we need to ensure that we stay within the maximum capacity of the event so please indicate if a parent will be staying for the event. Exact start times will be communicated in due course.

During the event we will have a comfort break half way through, and before the presentation, so feel free to bring food to eat. We also plan to have the urn available for hot drinks so bring your own mugs.

Even (or especially) if you have never taken part in an archery competition before, please try this one. Nothing to be scared of – the only person that will be examining your score, be it high or low, will be you. We will be presenting small prizes at the end of each session so stick around and soak up the atmosphere.

There is a £5 charge to take part in this event. Any “profit” from the event will go into club funds – the lack of events this summer mean that finances over the next year are going to be quite tight – so every little helps! Entries should be sent back electronically as indicated and all payments should be by bank transfer, with a reference “BHSHOOT” and your surname.
