There will be a £1.00 additional charge for any entries received after the closing date, also any archer entering will be expected to pay the entry fee if the shoot or not.

Medals will be awarded over all categories depending on how many archers are shooting within that category, as follows:

**Gold = awarded if there are 1-3 archers shooting**

**Gold & Silver = awarded if there are 4-6 archers shooting**

**Gold, Silver, & Bronze = awarded if there are 7 or more archers shooting**

## Notes

**Signing the entry form means you have read, understood and accepted these notes, as appropriate.**

1: Receipt of fee does not guarantee a place if the target list is already full.

2: junior ages must be specified on the entry form

3: Juniors wishing to shoot a higher round than of their own (within the junior rounds) will still pay the junior fee but will compete against the age group they are shooting in for medals.

4: Juniors wishing to shoot in the senior rounds will pay the senior fee to do so and will be competing against the seniors for medals.

Please ensure Junior rounds are specified correctly when filling out the entry form, as there may not be room to move people around on the day.

5: Any archer shooting a round shorter than appropriate to their age and / or gender is shooting for experience only and will not qualify for any medals.

6: Archers with handicaps (awarded at the start of 2021 Outdoor Season) equal to /less than the following are expected to shoot a New or Long National:

Lady Recurve archers with a handicap of 50

Gents Recurve archers with a handicap of 44

Lady Compound archers with handicap of 42

Gents Compound archers with a handicap of 37

7: Disabled archers should notify the organiser of the nature of their disability and any special requirements, eg: use of wheelchair or stool for shooting and/or the need to remain on the shooting line. If you are visually impaired, do you need a spotter? The organisers will do their best to accommodate you and meet your requirements.

8: **Parents & Guardians:** Please be aware that by entering your child you are also accepting that photography and photographs may be taken at the event by authorised photographers. If you do not wish such photographs of you or your child to be used in this way, please enter **N** under 'Photos' on the Entry Form. Otherwise, you accept this situation and give permission for this to happen.

9: The following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitions (for example, Target Lists & Results may be published) First and Surnames, Gender, Bow Style, DOB, / Age category, Email Address, Phone Number, Club / County/ Region, Round, Disabled Y/N Disability info (if necessary) **No information will be shared to any third party other than those stated above.**

10: All entrants must be members of archery GB. Membership cards may be asked for at registration.

11; We will accept no liability for any loss or damage to any property / equipment during the tournament for any reason.

**12: The field/range is in its first year of development from previously being an agricultural field. It is subject to uneven surface therefore care should be taken when walking about – no liability accepted for injury as a result of entering/attending the competition.**

**JUNIORS:** It may be necessary that we ask juniors to shoot during the morning at this event. We will inform you before the event date if this is the case.
